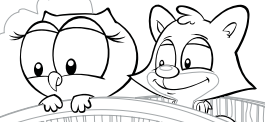


Solving Problems



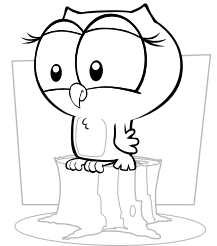
Video, Worksheet, and Discussion Starters

Suggested discussion starters after showing the "Solving Problems" video:

- What were the steps in the video?
- In step 2, Hunter thought about many different possible solutions to his problem of crossing the creek. Which solutions did he decide to not try and why? Which solution did he decide to try? Why did he try this solution?
- What kinds of things can you do to solve problems in the future?
